This course is for the Wyoming certified peace officer who has completed the Peace Officer Basic or the Detention Officer Basic Course and wishes to increase his/her proficiency with the handgun, shotgun, and rifle. **This course is also a prerequisite to attend the W.L.E.A. Firearms Instructor Certification Course.**

The focus of this course is not to teach the students how to shoot at the Basic level, and time will not allow the remedial training of those who cannot meet the standards listed below.

Classroom instruction will include focus on a firearms safety update.

Range practicum will include training in handgun, shotgun, and rifle. Specifically, time will be spent in the following areas:

- Weapon handling skills under stress
- Tactical carbine
- Movement, pivots and turns
- Shooting while moving
- Unconventional shooting positions
- Multiple target-varied distance drills
- One-handed pistol shooting
- Low light/no light shooting
- "One-on-one" competition
- Moving targets
- Use of cover
- Disabled limb drills
- Transition drills

PREREQUISITES:

On the first day of the course, each applicant must:

- ✓ Shoot passing scores (as noted below) on the following WLEA Proficiency Courses.
 - WLEA Pistol Proficiency Course (80%)
 - WLEA Shotgun Slug Phase (80%)
 - WLEA Shotgun Buckshot Phase (80%)

FAILURE TO MEET THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS WILL RESULT IN THE APPLICANT BEING DENIED CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN THE SCHOOL!

EQUIPMENT LIST

W.L.E.A. FIREARMS TRAINING – ADVANCED April 4 - 8, 2011

Please bring the following supplies and equipment for the Firearms Training – Advanced course:

- Semi-Auto rifle with sling – Patrol Rifle
- Minimum of 3, 10 round rifle magazines or larger
- Shotgun with sling (rifle sights strongly recommended)
- Duty handgun with duty leather
- 4 magazines for semi-auto's
- 4 speed loaders for revolvers
- **Ballistic Vest**
- Pad for prone shooting (optional)
- 2 Flashlights
- Shotgun, Rifle, and Handgun cleaning equipment
- Ear protection
- Eye protection (wrap around style with poly-carbonate lenses are **mandatory**)
- Baseball style cap
- Clothing suitable for **all** weather and range conditions
- Sun Screen
- Elbow and knee pads
- Camelback, or other hydration system, strongly recommended
- Ammunition

Shotgun – 75 rounds of **LEAD FREE FRANGIBLE** shotgun slugs

- 150 rounds of **LEAD FREE FRANGIBLE** 00 Buckshot

Duty Handgun – 1500 rounds OF **LEAD FREE FRANGIBLE** handgun ammunition

Patrol Rifle – 300 rounds of **LEAD FREE FRANGIBLE** carbine ammunition

To complete the application process for this Course, each Officer will be required to shoot scores of at least 80% on the WLEA Pistol Proficiency, 80% on the WLEA Patrol Rifle, 80% on the WLEA Shotgun Slug and 80% on the WLEA Shotgun 00 Buck Course. This will take place the first day of the Course. Proficiency will only be offered on the first day of the course and only three attempts will be allowed. The majority of the five (5) days will be spent on the range. There will be a relaxed dress code however collared shirts are required for all classroom sessions.
