

W.L.E.A. CUSTODY AND CONTROL INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION

July 25 – August 5, 2011
(80 P.O.S.T. Credit Hours)

This course is designed for Wyoming certified peace officers and detention officers that are, or will be assigned training responsibilities in custody and control. The course is intended to provide the students with the knowledge and skills necessary to receive Wyoming Law Enforcement Academy instructor certification, and successful completion of the course will be required before the student may apply for and receive certification.

The students will be trained in the entire system taught by the Academy, covering such skills as empty hands control, self-defense techniques, straight baton skills (including expandable), weapon retention and disarming techniques, handcuffing, and edged weapon defense skills.

The course will be very demanding physically and will be 95% hands-on skill development. A great amount of time will be spent learning the skills and practicing them. In addition the students will be taught how to teach and will be required to instruct others. This is a pass/fail course with certificates of successful completion being awarded only to those who are able to pass a written and a performance test. Upon the successful completion of the course, each instructor will be issued a W.L.E.A. Custody & Control Instructor's Manual and shirt.

PREREQUISITE:

On the first day of the course, each applicant must:

- ✓ Successfully complete the W.L.E.A. Physical Fitness assessment, with a 50% average and no less than 25% in each area. If you require further information on this assessment, please contact Ron Hayes.
