

DETENTION OFFICER WYOMING CRIMINAL LAW and PROCEDURES

This course is required by Wyoming's Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission for all officers previously certified in states with P.O.S.T. Certified Detention Basic Courses of 292 hours or more. This program provides a comprehensive view of Wyoming statutes and procedures, Use of Force issues, as well as an update of Constitutional Legal issues, Medical Legal issues, Juvenile Law and Police Civil Liability.

Please note: This course is also ideal for any experienced officer who needs or desires a complete review and refresher of all legislative and case-law which is pertinent to the job.

Please be advised that acceptance of the applicant by the Academy, by itself, does not exempt the officer from attending the Wyoming Detention Officer Basic Course. **All applications for detention officer certification and requests for exemption from the Basic Course must be made directly to P.O.S.T.**
