

# CRIMINAL/DRUG INTERDICTION FOR THE PATROL OFFICER

May 19-20, 2010  
(16 P.O.S.T. Credit Hours)

Designed for the working patrol officer this two-day course will provide a practical, Wyoming-based view of Drug and Criminal Interdiction. Course will target local and transcontinental smugglers.

Instructed by Jason Green, a 10 year veteran of the Wyoming Highway Patrol. Trooper Green has over 100 arrests and convictions for drug related stops in State and Federal Courts. Trooper Green has been a K-9 Handler since 2001. He has attended numerous Interdiction seminars and conferences throughout the country. He has instructed Interdiction Courses for Local, State and Federal agencies.

The course will cover;

- Legal traffic stops and questions that can and cannot be asked.
- Why Racial Profiling is unsuccessful and illegal.
- Clarifying questions to separate the innocent motoring public from the smugglers who try and blend in.
- Legal update on search and seizure.
- Methods of searching.
- Recent trends in the smuggling of contraband.
- Indicators to give rise to suspicion.
- Compartments used to smuggle contraband.
- Legal requirements to detain for a K-9 sniff.
- What the Officer should expect from the responding K-9 handler.
- Review of cases that pertain to detention for the K-9.
- How the alert or non alert of the K-9 may impact your case.
