

# EVO INSTRUCTOR COURSE

August 15 – 19, 2011  
(40 P.O.S.T. Credit Hours)

This course is designed for certified law enforcement personnel who are or will be assigned to train staff in Emergency Vehicle Operations.

There will be a skills test on the first day of class to determine the students driving skill upon entering class. The student will be required to, after orientation to each course, run each course in an allotted period of time or designated speed and hit no cones. The courses and times are as follows:

- ✓ Basic Skills Course: 1 minute 10 seconds, cone free;
- ✓ Accident Avoidance: 35 miles per hour minimum, cone free;
- ✓ Skid Car Course: Ability to run the course at full slick, cone free.

**FAILURE TO MEET THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS WILL RESULT IN THE APPLICANT BEING DENIED CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN THE SCHOOL**

The topics covered in the course will include:

- Liability
- Vehicle inspection, brakes and restraints
- Precision Driving Skills
- Adult Learning Theory
- Developing and designing a driving course
- Teaching driving fundamentals
- Student run courses
- Night driving

The focus of this course is not to teach the students how to drive it is to teach students how to instruct effective emergency vehicle operation courses. Time will not allow the remedial training of those who cannot meet the standards listed above.

This course will be taught by W.L.E.A., EVOC certified instructors.
