

W.L.E.A. FIREARMS INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION COURSE

July 25 – August 5, 2011
(80 P.O.S.T. Credit Hours)

This two-week course is designed for the Wyoming certified peace officer and detention officer who is, or who will be assigned the responsibility of firearms training for his/her agency.

This intensive 2-week course will combine classroom instruction, range participation and homework assignments. The course will cover both handguns and shotguns, but will not cover rifles. Upon completion of the course, the student will be capable of developing and delivering firearms training courses, assisting the agency's administrative team in developing firearms and training policy, assessing and meeting department training needs, as well as assisting problem shooters and running a safe and efficient range.

The focus of this course is not to teach the students how to shoot, and time will not allow the remedial training of those who cannot meet the standards listed below.

UPON THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THIS COURSE, THE STUDENT WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE DUAL-CERTIFIED AS BOTH A P.O.S.T. AND A W.L.E.A. CERTIFIED FIREARMS INSTRUCTOR! THE ADMINISTRATOR'S SIGNATURE ON THE COURSE APPLICATION WILL AUTHORIZE THE CERTIFICATION PROCESS.

PREREQUISITES:

Accompanying the application for the course, each applicant must include:

- ✓ Documentation of his/her successful completion of the W.L.E.A. Advanced Firearms Course.

On the first day of the course, each applicant must:

- ✓ Shoot passing scores (as noted below) on the following WLEA Proficiency Courses.
 1. WLEA Pistol Proficiency Course (90%)
 2. WLEA Shotgun Slug Phase (90%)
 3. WLEA Shotgun Buckshot Phase (90%)

FAILURE TO MEET THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS WILL RESULT IN THE APPLICANT BEING DENIED CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN THE SCHOOL!

EQUIPMENT LIST

All Ammunition MUST BE 100% LEAD FREE

- Duty Handgun and Support Equipment (holster, belt, keepers, speed loader or magazine case, etc.)
- Minimum of Three speed loaders or Four magazines
- Patrol Rifle with sling
- 12 Gauge Shotgun with mandatory sling, (Rifle sights strongly recommended)
- **1000 rounds of LEAD FREE Frangible Handgun ammunition**
- **300 rounds Patrol Rifle LEAD FREE Frangible ammunition**
- **200 rounds of LEAD FREE Frangible 00 buck**
- **100 rounds of LEAD FREE Frangible Slugs**
- Minimum of two Flashlights and a flashlight ring
- Elbow and Knee pads
- Shoulder pad (optional)
- Eye protection (wrap around style with poly-carbonate lenses are **mandatory**)
- Ear protection
- Sun screen
- Hydration system (optional, but strongly recommended)
- Baseball style cap
- Ballistic vest
- Cleaning equipment for handgun and shotgun
- Clothing suitable for all weather and range conditions

There will be a relaxed dress code, but collared shirts are **mandatory** for classroom sessions.

To complete the application process for this Course, each Officer will be required to shoot scores of at least 90 % on the WLEA Pistol Proficiency, 90% with the WLEA Patrol Rifle Course, 90% on both the WLEA Shotgun Slug and WLEA Shotgun 00 Buck Course at the Wyoming Law Enforcement Academy. This will take place the first day of the Course.
