The focus is on the role and function of a supervisor, managing and evaluating performance, shaping and changing subordinate behavior. The program covers the legal aspects of supervision, documenting performance and approaches to discipline. Upon completion of the program, attendees should be able to successfully perform the major functions and duties associated with supervising and evaluating a group of employees in a law enforcement setting.
