

# ADVANCED GROUND DEFENSE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT

December 2 – 4, 2008  
(24 P.O.S.T. Credit Hours)

Students will receive training in advanced Ground Defense Tactics which are escape and control based. The course is designed for peace officers and detention officers who wish to improve their abilities and confidence when a dynamic situation ends up on the ground.

The course will be very physically demanding and will be 95% hands-on skill development and drill participation. Students will spend a great deal of time doing drills and perfecting the skills that will allow them to survive and win a “ground fight” scenario.

The course will be instructed by the WLEA Custody and Control Staff with the assistance of Daryl Johnson of DJ Tactics LLC, in Montgomery, Alabama. Mr. Johnson has developed ground defense systems for Colorado Springs and Denver area SWAT Teams as well as assisting in the development of a ground defense system for the Kansas City Police Department. Daryl has competed successfully in international Jui-Jitsu competition and is now training Law Enforcement defense tactics full time after retiring from the Colorado Springs Police Department.

Attendance preference will be given to agency custody and control instructors. This is an advanced tactics training course and not a certification.
