



MASTER INSTRUCTOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

July 18-20, 2011

The IALEFI Master Instructor development program is not a “shooting school” per se, but rather an experience to make you a better communicator in imparting critical survival skills. It is specifically designed for individuals already certified as firearms instructors to continue their education and attend quality training at minimum cost.

Focus will be on the enhancement of teaching skills on the three primary law enforcement weapon systems---handgun, shotgun and rifle. A full day of instruction will be provided on each system by individuals who are recognized subject matter experts in their respective disciplines. An additional block of training on low light threat management will be included.

Students will be exposed to a number of skill building and evaluation drills. Live fire exercises will be both demanding and challenging and attendees should be in good physical condition. Our goal is to provide a quality service so that we may better prepare our law enforcement officers who go in harms way.

Course Requirements:

1. Currently certified law enforcement or military firearms instructor in all three disciplines.

2. Service handgun, concealment holster and/or duty rig, at least 3 magazines or speedloaders, 4 dummy rounds for each weapon (.223, .308, 9mm, .40 and .45 dummy rounds will be available for use through WLEA).
3. Semi-auto rifle with a sling and a minimum of 3 magazines.
4. Pump or Semi-auto shotgun with a sling.
5. **ALL AMMUNITION MUST BE LEAD-FREE/FRANGIBLE:** At least 600 rounds for handgun, 350 rounds for rifle, 15 rifled slugs for shotgun, 100 additional shotgun rounds (at least 25 should be buckshot, with the remainder being #4 or less).
6. Wrap around eye protection, ear protection and brimmed hat.
