

# REMINGTON FIELD ARMORER TRAINING SCHOOL (Model 870)

Session A: June 7-8, 2010

**or**

Session B: June 9-10, 2010 \*\*

(16 P.O.S.T. Credit Hours)

This course is designed for any certified Law Enforcement or Military personnel who are or will be responsible for the maintenance and repair of the Remington model 870 shotgun.

The course will provide the student with the knowledge and skills to properly care for this weapon. The topics covered will include:

- ✓ Ordering parts, Tool Use, Factory Service
- ✓ M/870 Disassembly and re-assembly, Initial inspection, Safety concerns, Repair procedures & adjustments, Older and newer style parts, Service checks, Maintenance of shotgun & cleaning procedures, barrel stampings & serial number structure

Each student will be required to disassemble and trouble-shoot several "rigged" weapons as a practical test of their knowledge and skills. In addition, a written examination will be administered.

Each student must bring an 870 shotgun to the course, and safety glasses are recommended.

This course will be taught by a Remington factory armorer.
