

TASER X26 Instructor Course – June 15-16, 2011

This course will certify you to instruct others on the use of the X26 TASER Electronic Control Devices. Taser Instructor courses are open to sworn law enforcement and active duty military personnel.

New persons certifying as an instructor will need to complete four hours of online training and attend BOTH practical days. Re-certifying TASER Instructors will need to complete eight hours of online training and the SECOND day (Day 2) of the practical session. **Cost: \$350 New Certification or \$175 Re-Certification.**

To Register: This course has an online component that **MUST** be completed prior to attending the practical portion of instruction with a TASER Master Instructor. Registration is managed by the Northeast Wisconsin Technical College (NWTC).
