

PEACE OFFICER WYOMING CRIMINAL LAW and PROCEDURES

This course will be offered in conjunction with every Peace Officer Basic Course. Due to schedule changes, the dates of these courses may change. Please contact Sonja Erickson for specific dates. Every student who enrolls and is accepted into this course must attend and test during the same Basic session.

(67 P.O.S.T. Credit Hours)

This course is required by Wyoming's Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission for all officers previously certified in states with P.O.S.T. Certified Basic Courses of 537 hours or more. This program provides a comprehensive view of Wyoming statutes and procedures, Use of Force issues, Domestic Violence law and procedures, as well as an update of Laws of Arrest, Search and Seizure, Rules of Evidence, Laws of Interrogation, Juvenile Law, and Police Civil Liability.

Please note: This course is also ideal for any experienced officer who needs or desires a complete review and refresher of all legislative and case-law which is pertinent to the job.

Please be advised that acceptance of the applicant by the Academy, by itself, does not exempt the officer from attending the Wyoming Peace Officer Basic Course. **All applications for peace officer certification and requests for exemption from the Basic Course must be made directly to P.O.S.T.**
