### Incident Command System, ICS-300 Intermediate

The Incident Command System, ICS-300 Intermediate Course will be held on February 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup>, 2008 hosted by Sublette County Emergency Management. The course begins at 8:00 a.m. at the **Pinedale Fire Station at 130 South Fremont Avenue in Pinedale, WY.** This course is for all first responders regardless of their discipline.

Prior to attending this course, applicants must complete IS-100, IS-200, and IS-700. These course prerequisites are available as online independent study courses via the FEMA/EMI website <http://training.fema.gov/EMIWeb/IS/>.

IS 100-ICS 100 Introduction to the Incident Command System  
IS 200-ICS 200 Incident Command System Basic  
IS 700-NIMS 700 National Incident Management System, an Introduction

It is recommended that participants have worked within the ICS structure or have some practical application of its principals.
