Wyoming Detention Officer Basic Course

This basic certification course utilizes an integrated, phased teaching approach and guided experiential learning concepts. Students are taught and evaluated on a curriculum established and certified by the Wyoming Law Enforcement Academy and the Wyoming Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission in the core competencies of criminal law, interpersonal interactions, professional skills, enforcement skills, and investigative skills.

Students are required to have a Wyoming P.O.S.T. Temporary Certification and be employed by a Wyoming Law Enforcement Agency or be a Pre-Service Candidate. Given the physically demanding nature of this course, students are required to complete the W.L.E.A. Physical Fitness Assessment to the prescribed Cooper Standards on the morning of the first campus day in order to continue training.

To receive certification students must attend and successfully complete all aspects of the curricula.
